ADAPTIVE PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER

TITLE/POSITION

RETIREMENT: Teacher Retirement System of Georgia

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: 190 Days

REPORTS TO: Principal and Director of Special Education

QUALIFICATIONS: Valid Georgia certification on Physical Education and Special Education.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated annually in accordance with provisions of the Board's Policy on evaluation.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work with parents /guardians to develop and provide an appropriate special program to eligible exceptional students.
- Observe, test, and/or evaluate students with physical problems in physical education.
- Counsel classroom or physical education teachers on how to effectively meet the needs of students with physical problems.
- Assist students with physical problems who are unable to participate in regular physical education classes by structuring and conducting an individual or small group program.
- Review each student's progress quarterly for needed changes in student's program.
- Conduct annual evaluation of students in adaptive programs to determine if the student's problem has been corrected.
- Participate in training programs to increase skills and proficiency related to assignment.
- Review current developments, literature, and technical source information related to job responsibilities.
- Ensure adherence to good safety procedures.
- Follow federal and state laws, as well as Board policies.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
