PERFORMANCE

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide a hearing program that will allow hearing impaired students to achieve at their maximum potential.
- Interpret teachers, classmates, and other school personnel's language and discussion to select hearing impaired/deaf students.
- Translate hearing impaired/deaf students' language to teachers, classmates, and other school personnel.
- Accompany and assist hearing impaired/deaf students as necessary on field trips, co-curricular activities held during the school day, assemblies, etc.
- Substitute when necessary in HI instructor's absence.
- Participate, as requested, in staff development activities, committee meetings etc.
- Participate in training programs to increase skills and proficiency related to assignment.
- Review current developments, literature, and technical source information related to job responsibilities.
- Ensure adherence to good safety procedures.
- Follow federal and state laws, as well as Board policies.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
