## **SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH UPDATE**

### **Search Proceeding on Schedule**

Jasper, GA – The search for the next Superintendent of the Pickens County School District is progressing on schedule and as planned. The Board of Education has reviewed all 49 applications received, conducted first-round interviews with seven applicants, and scheduled additional first-round interviews as well as some second-round interviews.

One applicant withdrew from consideration to accept another position. No other applicants have been eliminated. Applicants other than the first seven called for first-round interviews may be selected for initial or second interviews.

The Board hopes to name one, two or three finalists in late April for the 14-day period of public comment (as required by law) before formally employing the Superintendent.

The Board appreciates the guidance and support from Dr. Charles Webb, Interim Superintendent. “Dr. Webb has been superb in running the Pickens County School District, enabling the Board to take sufficient time to consider the best applicants and select the best person as the new Superintendent,” states Daniel Bell, Board Chair.
